

in China. Two major pharmaceutical CROs in China will describe their service and collaborative models for drug discovery. A number of projects from the US academic investigators will be available for collaborations.

- Academic investigators and students in all areas of biotech and pharmaceutical sciences.
- Executives and opinion leaders in pharmaceutical CROs.
